Sale Guidelines

- All consignors must be members of the California Suffolk & Hampshire Association. If not a current member, they can pay their membership fee at the sale (\$25).
- Consignors are invited to put 1 in the online sale and MAX of 5 in the pen sale.
- Must be born no earlier than late September.
- NO dwarfs or sick lambs.
- Must have no more than 30 days of fleece.
- Pen sale animals must be pre-priced between \$500-\$750.

Online Sale

Commission: 8%

The purpose of the online sale is to offer higher-valued animals for larger budgets. If you believe the animal is worth more than \$1,000 and you have buyers interested, this would be a good option. You do NOT have to put one in if you choose not to.

- Animals that don't sell online can be offered in the pen sale; it's your choice.
- All online sale animals will be present at the pen sale for preview. Lot numbers will be painted on them.

Pen Sale

Commission: \$25 per head

In-person only at MJC ACE Pavilion on West Campus, Modesto, CA

- You will be provided one 6x6 pen and a sign that includes your farm name, price range of the animals in the pen & QR code to the online sale.
 - All of the pen sale information will be submitted to Tim via an online form at a future date.
- Any additional signs, racks, stands, etc. are permitted.
- Please keep your pen sale prices between \$500-\$750.
- Please make sure animals are clean, well presented, and marketable. This helps everyone.
- Sale is first come, first served. If multiple buyers are interested, you may have to conduct brief, informal bidding. **To read all buying procedures, please reference the “buying procedures” document.**

Check out procedures

- MJC will handle payment for all animals. Once the sale is complete, you will receive an envelope with all checks/cash & bill of sale.
- A check from SOnlineSales will be mailed to you for the online sale. Please **DO NOT accept payment for your online sales animals at the event.**
